- Shirley (Warwickshire) Royal British Legion Club Ltd, registered number & 14790R under the Industrial and Provident Act 1965, is a data controller as defined in section 1(1) of the Data Protection Act 1998 (“the Act”), in respect of the processing of personal data carried out by it and is referred to in this Undertaking as the “data controller”.
- Section 4(4) of the Act provides that, subject to section 27(1) of the Act, it is the duty of a data controller to comply with the data protection principles in relation to all personal data with respect to which it is the data controller.
- Following an investigation into a complaint received by the Information Commissioner (the “Commissioner”), the Commissioner is satisfied that the data controller has breached the seventh data protection principle.
- The Seventh Data Protection Principle is set out in Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Act and a copy is attached to this Undertaking.
- On 20th March 2008, (Name removed) the Chairman made representations to the Commissioner’s Investigating Officer, namely Mrs Diana Shields.
- Following consideration of those representations it has been agreed that, in consideration of the Commissioner not exercising his powers to serve an Enforcement Notice under section 40 of the Act or to take any other regulatory action, the data controller undertakes as follows:-

The data controller shall, as from the date of this undertaking and for so long as similar standards are required by the Act or other successor legislation from other data controllers in similar circumstances, ensure that personal data is processed in accordance with the Seventh Data Protection Principle in Schedule 1 Part 1 of the Act.

I understand that a breach of the undertaking may lead to supervisory action being taken against the data controller under the Act.
